Established in 2001, Peace House Africa is a US-based, 501(c)3 nonprofit organization working in Tanzania, East Africa. Our goal is to create a positive, sustainable future for AIDS orphans and their communities.

Without parents to support them, many children are often forced to abandon school. Without an education, orphans face a bleak future with little hope. All of our initiatives directly address the critical education needs of orphans in Tanzania.

PEACE HOUSE SECONDARY SCHOOL

Opened in 2007, this unique and dynamic boarding school for orphans and vulnerable children is already home to over 200 students, with about 120 new students being enrolled each year. A key goal is for Peace House Secondary School (PHS) graduates to become job creators — young people who can build a sustainable future for Tanzania.

PEACE HOUSE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

In addition to the students at PHS, Peace House currently provides financial support to over 500 orphaned and vulnerable children, allowing them to attend a variety of primary and secondary schools in their community.
